








#### WHAT IS CERVICAL CANCER '?


- This is a cancer that affects the neck of the womb called the cervix.
- The major risk factor for its cause is HUMAN PAPILLOMA VIRUS infection, which is a sexually transmitted virus.
- The key is prevention and early detection.






#### **DID YOU KNOW THAT**

- Cancer of the cervix is the 3rd most common cancer among women worldwide, with an estimated 569,847 new cases and 311,365 deaths in 2018 (GLOBOCAN)
- About 14,943 new cervical cancer cases are diagnosed annually in Nigeria (estimates for 2018). Cervical cancer ranks as the 2nd leading cause of female cancer in Nigeria. Cervical cancer is the 2nd most common female cancer in women aged 15 to 44 years in Nigeria.











#### PREVENTION


➤Cervical cancer is PREVENTABLE and remains one of the most preventable cancers.


